



Teacher - ELL Support

Position Summary:

The Teacher - ELL Support is a part-time position serving 1-2 sites in an Aim High region. The Teacher - ELL Support works with faculty, staff, and students to create a successful learning environment for English Language Learners. This involves developing successful learning environments in each classroom, and providing campus-wide professional development to ensure teachers: plan with language demands in mind, implement differentiated instruction, and create classroom systems that support student success.

Duties & Responsibilities may include: (to be determined by Co-Directors)

- Collaborate with teaching teams to design and implement engaging instruction that leads to English language fluency in all content areas
- Attend planning sessions with teaching teams to help develop strategies and lessons to support student understanding of content
- Recommend modifications and lesson structures that will support identified students as well as unidentified students with different learning styles
- Identify students who may need English language supplemental services and determine the level and nature of services for each student
- As needed, work with individual students or small groups to support newcomer students in acquiring English language skills to participate in all Aim High activities

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in the field of education
- Prior teaching experience, and experience working with English Language Learners in a school setting
- Experience in providing professional development/mentoring teachers
- Responsible, diligent, conscientious, and possess strong leadership and communication skills

Desired Qualifications:

- Fluency in Cantonese and/or Spanish
- BCLAD, CLAD, CELTA, or TESOL endorsement or certificate
- Master's Degree in Education

Compensation and Schedule:

Teacher - ELL Support receives a competitive salary for the summer. Salary commensurate with experience. This is a part-time position, over six weeks of the Aim High program. A typical schedule will be four days a week from 8am to 1pm at two Aim High campuses. Please see aimhigh.org for dates, which vary by region.
