Aim High is seeking English Language Learner teachers for Summer 2019. The Teachers - English Language Learner (ELL Specialist) is a part-time position serving 1-2 sites in one Aim High region. The Teachers - English Language Learner works with faculty, staff, and students to create a successful learning environment for English Language Learners.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead the development of a successful learning environment for ELL students in each classroom by
 providing campus wide professional development to facilitate clear planning around student needs
 and learning, differentiated instruction, and classroom structures that support student success.
- Plan and collaborate with teachers to design and implement engaging instruction that leads to English language fluency in all content areas.
- Attend planning sessions with teachers to help develop strategies and lessons to support student understanding of content.
- Suggest modifications as well as lesson structures that will support identified students as well as unidentified students with different learning styles.
- Identify students who may need English language supplemental services and determine the level and nature of services for each student.
- As needed, work with individual students or small groups to support newcomer students in acquiring English language skills to participate in all Aim High activities
