APPLICATION TIPS

Remember the following steps when applying to City College of San Francisco.



Application –

- After submitting city college application, students will receive an email confirmation that includes your ID number (begins with "W" or "@").
 - Set up and log in to your CCSF email – students will receive a separate email from CCSF with their new CCSF email address. All official CCSF communications, such as information about Registration Appointments will be sent to their CCSF email address.
 - Students need to activate their RAM ID – students will need to log into myRAM portal in order to register for classes. Complete the following steps:
 - Under Username: Enter Your Student ID Number
 - Click on the red "New to RAM ID?" box to set up your RAM ID account
 - Please allow 24 hours for your RAM ID to be activated
 - Once your RAM ID has been initialized, click on myRAM Portal
 - View RAM ID Step by Step Guide for additional assistance

Placement – two part process:

- HS Data Form and Transcript – Students complete Online Form and attach their transcript
- Review and Placement – CCSF matriculation office will review this data and determine the appropriate English and Math course placement. Students will be able to view their placements in their student portal.

Orientation – students can complete the orientation online independently

Counseling – Students can drop in to meet with a Counselor Virtual and that Counselor can help them sign up for Summer or Fall classes.
